Another successful day. It was 8:02 a.m. when I departed Johnson Lake. It was 64 degrees and cloudy. The forecast for areas that I would be driving through called for chances of rain so I took the side curtains out from under the seat and put them on top of all of the stuff in the back seat so that they would be readily available. As it turned out, I didn't need them. As the day progressed the clouds thinned and eventually turned to mostly sunny. It was pretty cool all day. I checked the temperature in Akron, Colorado when I stopped for gas at 3:30 and it was only 79, and it is 75 now in Limon at about 5:30. A very comfortable day for a drive.

I arrived in Limon at about 4:30. Keep in mind that I went from central to mountain time zone though, so it was actually  $9\frac{1}{2}$  hours of drive time and not the  $8\frac{1}{2}$  that the clock indicates. The Super 8 motel that I had booked looked pretty tacky. I checked out the rooms, and although pretty old they seem to be clean and comfortable enough. And yes I did check for bedbugs. OK there!

The car ran very well most of the day. After getting gas in Akron, however, it started missing occasionally. I was blaming the gas, but I had only put in about 5 gallons. The rest of the gas should have diluted it sufficiently if it were poor gas. As I drove it would run fine for a while and then miss some. I am now suspecting that I may have some fouled spark plugs. I will be changing them out later this evening and we will see how that works. Hope for the best.

I am having trouble with the internet connection at the motel, so I think I will go for dinner and see if I can find a hot spot out somewhere that I can connect to. If this gets posted you know that I was successful.
