He went over and tapped each of the spokes with a hammer handle and found a couple of spokes that were a little loose on that wheel as well. He got out his tools and shims and we proceeded to install some shims under the end of the spokes. We then checked the front wheels and found a few spokes on each of them that needed some shims as well. They are all now tight and ready to roll.

I then came back to mom's place and we had lunch and then went out to Trader Joe's to pick up some wine and some supplies for dinner. After dropping off some things back at mom's we loaded up the rest in the Model T and drove over to my sister's place. We did another round of spa and wine then Susie built the soup for dinner.

After dinner I gave a ride in the Model T to my sister, Tanya, and to my niece Ann and her daughter Rina.
